Sonai Irrigation Project

The New Sonai Major Irrigation Project is located in the Cachar District of Assam near Kashithal village on the River Sonai. The location of the proposed Barrage axis is at Kashithal just downstream of Agrikhal Nala and about 3 Km downstream of the confluence of Chekarcham with Sonai River.

The Sonai Irrigation Project with a CCA of 10850 Ha and UIP of 17360 Ha is a Major Irrigation Project also having component of drinking water supply and other associated benefits such as peciculture, animal husbandry and communication. It envisages construction of a gated barrage of 170m water way across the river Sonai. The estimated cost of the project is Rs. 799.50 Cr. (Net) at Price Level of 2017-18 as per SOR of WRD & other SOR of PWD etc.

DPR of the project has been uploaded in e-PAMS on 28.10.2020 and the same has been forwarded to concerned Directorates in CWC for examination on 9.11.2020 through e-PAMS.

Cost Appraisal-I Dte communicated to Project authority through e-PAMS on 19.11.2020 that the sub head wise detailed estimate with supporting documents has not been appended with Cost Estimate Chapter, it has only Abstract of Cost. Therefore, it is requested to submit the head wise detailed estimate with all supporting documents as per CWC Guidelines at the earliest for its examination on cost aspect.
