{ MY INDIA } RIVERS IN SPATE

4 die in UP as heavy rainfall batters state



Moderate to heavy rain continued to batter different parts of the country, causing severe waterlogging and flood-like situation, with Uttar Pradesh reporting deaths of at least four people in rain-related incidents over the weekend, officials said. Parts of southern West Bengal, including Kolkata, also received moderate to heavy rain on Sunday under the impact of a deep depression in the region, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) said, adding light to moderate rains are likely in the city over the next 12 hours. Many rivers in Uttar Pradesh, including the Ganga, were flowing above the danger mark after heavy monsoon rainfall, with the Met department predicting more heavy rain and "thunderstorm accompanied with lightning" at isolated places over east UP.

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
