185 tanks in Hyderabad overflowing after rain

Central team will visit Hyderabad to assess damage

Telangana Principal Irrigation Secretary Rajat Kumar on Wednesday said all 185 tanks in Hyderabad were overflowing following heavy rain over the past week.

Mr. Kumar held a meeting with irrigation officials and constituted 15 teams to monitor the situation at tanks round the clock and inform higher officials.

Speaking to reporters, he said except three tanks – Pal-lechuruvu at Rajendranagar, Appacheruvu at Gaganpahad and Gurram Cheruvu at Balapur – which suffered major breaches, none of the remaining 182 tanks were a concern. The repairs to the three tanks were carried out within twelve hours. There

were minor damages to 53 tanks.

CM's directive

Chief Minister K. Chandrababtu Naidu asked officials to take steps to guard against the danger of tanks in Hyderabad breaching in view of

the continuous rain and flooding of localities in the past few days.

Ex gratia payment

Minister of State for Home G. Kishan Reddy said a five-member Central team would tour Hyderabad and Telanga-

na to assess the damage to properties and crops during the recent heavy rain and flooding. A sum of ₹4 lakh each would be given as ex gratia to family members of the deceased and ₹2 lakh each to the disabled affected by the calamity.
