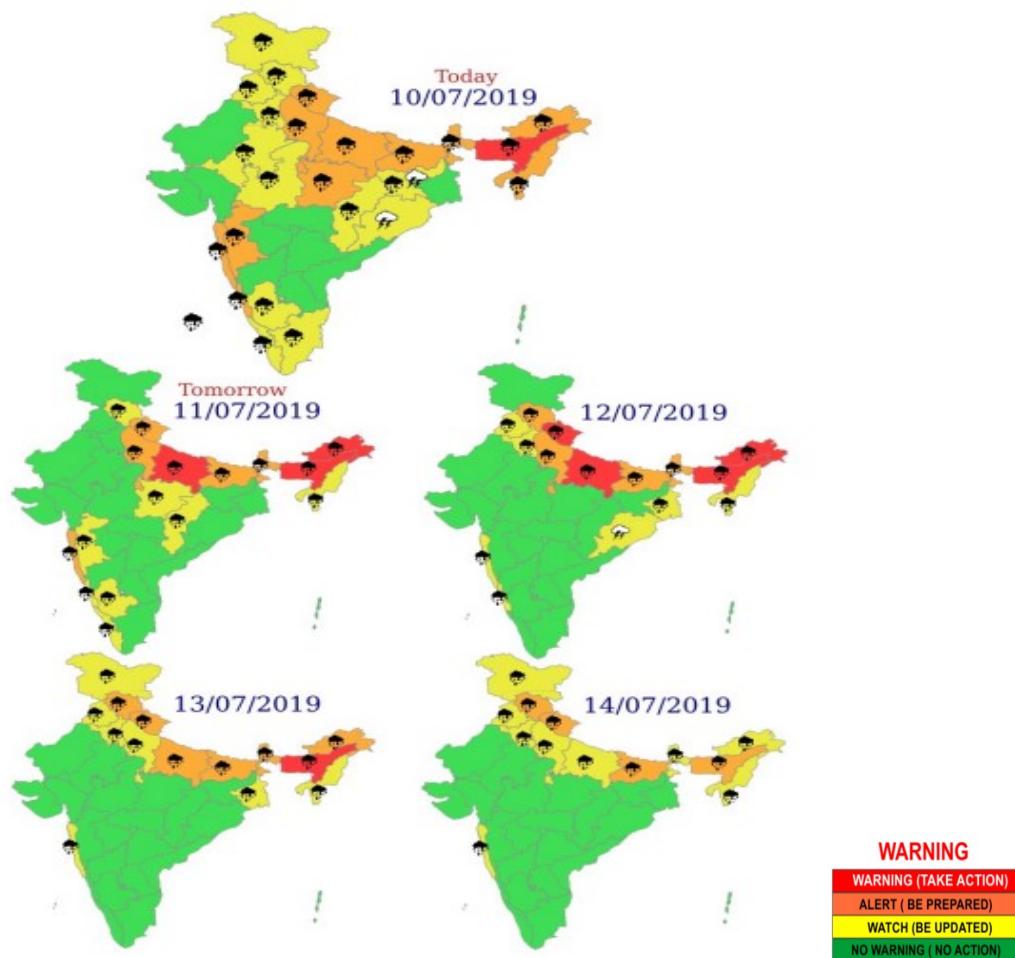

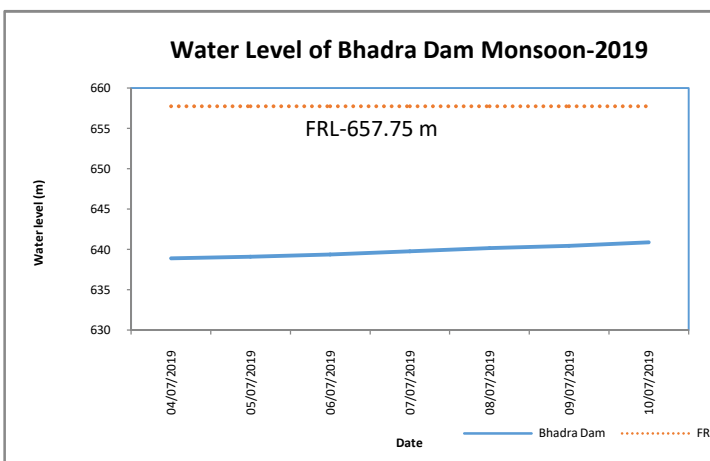

6. Flood situation as per actual/forecasted rainfall situation

Due to increase of rainfall and 48 hours of forecast rainfall in the Krishna and Cauvery Basin, the Inflow to the Dams (Kabini, Hemavathy, UTP & Bhadra) may increase in the next 24-48 hrs. The water level of West Flowing Rivers (WFR) South of Tapi may also increase in the next 24-48 hrs.
