ABSORPTION OF WORK CHARGED EMPLOYEES IN CWC.

## SHRI R.P. DAS

will the Minister of Irrigation be please to state:

- (a) the number of work charged employees working under C.W.C.
- (b) how many of them have so far been absorbed against regular permanent vacancies: and
- (c) The policies followed by the Commission in this regard?

Informations to be compiled after obtaining the same from field Offices.

As per rules 50% of the posts on W/c estt. which have continued for more than 3 years and likely to continue on long term basis have to be made permanent. The heads of offices concerned are processing the cases of confirmation of W/c staff against available permanent posts and then confirm the eligible employees.

## NOTE FOR SUPLEMENTARIES:

As per Ministry of Finance (Deptt. of Expenditure) 0.M. No. 8(1)-Estt(sp1)/60, dated 12-8-1960, 50% of the posts on W/c estt. which have been in-existence for more than 3 years and which are likely to continue on long term basis can be made permanent to enable the confirmation of W/c staff.

2. Each Circle is a separate unit of seniority for the various categories of W/c staff employed therein. As such the detailed information as to the number of W/c staff, employed is available in the Circle concerned and also the cases of confirmation of the W/c staff have to be processed by the heads of the offices of the Circles concerned. We have already advised the heads of sub-offices to expedite confirmation against the available permanent posts and the cases are in progress and under active consideration of the concerned heads of offices.

Kindly refer to your DO No. 14/7/84-Estt.I, the 28th Feb., 1984 sending therewith a copy of Unstarred Question No. 1382, regarding permanency to W/c staff for reply in the Lok Sabha.

In this connection it is stated that this Commission have already declared 50% of the W/c posts in the various field offices as permanent.

As regards permancacy of the staff, some of the SEs in-charge-of the Circles have already confirmed the eligible Workcharged employees against such permanent The cases of confirmation against the remaining permanent W/c posts are actively under process in the Circle Offices. The information regarding the exact number of W/c staff made permanent is not available in the Commission as this is done at the field level. The information is however being collected from field offices. This has the approval of the Member (P&P).

Subject: - Workcharged staff: Recommendation of the Pay Commission regarding.

The Govt. of India have had under consideration the recommendations of the Pay Commission regarding workcharged staff contained in Chapter XLVI of their report.

- In acceptance of the Pay Commission's recommendations the following decisions are recommended for the information of all concerned. .
- 3. W.C. Staff who are engaged on a casual or daily rates basis should be classified into industrial and non-industiral categories depending on the nature of their duties.
- For the purpose of such classification the following types of categories may be onsidered to be non-industrial:-
- Supervisory staff the minimum of scale of pay is not less than Rs. 200/- p.m.
  - Clerical Staff.
  - 3. Watch and Ward Staff.
  - 4. Conservancy Staff.
  - 5. Fire Fighting Staff.
  - 6. Mes sangerial Staff. Medical Staff.
- Workeharged staff in non-industrial categories may be brought on to the Regular Establishment thus entitling them to all the concessions dmissible to regular non-industrial staff.
- 6. As regards industrial categories permanent posts may be created to the extent of 50% of posts which have been in existence for more than 3 years and which are likely to continue on a long term basis enabling confirmation of Workeharged staff whose services are likely to be required on a permanent basis.
- Adequate safeguards for the proper administration of workcharged staff should also be taken by proper maintenance of their service records, drafting recruitment rules for each category/grade of posts, prescribing stand-ard trade tests wherever necessary, and also fixing yard stick for the creation of posts on the Workcharged establishment, wherever feasible.
- Workcharged staff in industrial categories would have the same conditions of service which are or may be prescribed for regular industrial staff.

9. Ministries/Dept 3: employing workcharged staff whose employment is not casual and whose services are likely to be required on a long term basis are requested to take action as indicated in paras 3-7 above and issue necessary orders (on the lines already issued by the M/W.H.&S in respect of W.C. Estt. of the C.P.W.D.) in consultation with the Min. of Finance.
