Very Extremely Heavy rainfall of (76-100) is predicted in MIDDLE GODAVARI, MANERU, on day 1.

Extremely Heavy rainfall of (51-75) is predicted in MANJIRA, on day 1.

Very Heavy rainfall of (38-50) is predicted in PENGANGA, WARDHA, WAINGANGA, LOWER GODAVARI, on day 1.

Heavy rainfall of (26-37) is predicted in PURNA, on day 1.and in UPPER GODAVARI, PRAVARA, PURNA, MIDDLE GODAVARI, PENGANGA, on day 2.

Light rainfall of (11-25) is predicted in INDRAVATHI, SABARI, on day 1. and in MANERU, WARDHA, WAINGANGA, LOWER GODAVARI, INDRAVATHI, SABARI, on day 2. and in UPPER GODAVARI, PRAVARA, PURNA, MANJIRA, on day 3.

Very light rainfall of (0.1-10mm) is predicted for all Subcatchments from Day 1 to Day 7 of Godavari Basin.

CWC Advisory: Heavy rainfall is predicted in the sub catchments of Middle Godavari, Maneru, Lower Godavari and Indravati of Godavari Basin. So there will be increase of water levels from Kaleswaram to Dowlaiswaram and also Jagdalpur in Indravati & Chinturu in Sabari sub catchment.

Reservoirs shown in red are having live storage greater than 90%, reservoirs shown in orange are having live storage greater than 75% and the reservoirs shown in yellow are having live storage greater than 70%. Close watch has to be maintained at these reservoirs wherever Heavy Rainfall (Yellow) and Very Heavy Rainfall (Orange) and Extremely Heavy Rainfall (Red) warning in next 24 hours are given (last column of Table above).
