Moderate Rainfall of (26-37mm) is Predicted in Subcatchments of Upper Godavari, Pravara and Manjira on Day 1 of Godavari Basin.

Light Rainfall of (11-25 mm) is Predicted in Subcatchments of Purna, Middle Godavari, Maneru, Penuganga, Wardha, Wainganga, Lower Godavari, Indravathi, and Sabari on Day 1, Upper Godavari, Pravara, Purna, Middle Godavari, Penganga, Wardha, Wainganga and Lower Godavari on Day2, Wainganga on Day 3 of Godavari Basin.

Remaining catchments will receive Very light rainfall of (0.1-10mm) is predicted for the remaining Days of Godavari Basin.
