Light rainfall of (11-25) is predicted in UPPER GODAVARI, PRAVARA, PURNA, LOWER GODAVARI, INDRAVATHI, on day 1. and in MANJIRA on day 3. and in UPPER GODAVARI, PRAVARA, PURNA, MANJIRA, WAINGANGA, on day 4.and in WAINGANGA, INDRAVATHI, SABARI on day 6. and in WAINGANGA, INDRAVATHI, SABARI on day 7.

Very light rainfall of (0.1-10mm) is predicted for all Subcatchments from Day 1 to Day 7 of Godavari Basin.

Close watch has to be maintained at these reservoirs wherever Heavy Rainfall (Yellow) and Very Heavy Rainfall (Orange) and Extremely Heavy Rainfall (Red) warning in next 24 hours are given (last column of Table above).
