
# 1.0 Rainfall Situation Chief Amount of rainfall recorded at 0830 hours IST of today (50 mm or more) as per IMD

#### 2.0 SYNOPTIC SITUATION: as per IMD dated: 19.07.2021

- SOUTHWEST MONSOON WAS VIGOROUS OVER NORTH INTERIOR KARNATAKA;
   ACTIVE OVER SOUTHINTERIOR KARNATAKA AND NORMAL OVER COASTAL KARNATAKA.
- THE MONSOON TROUGH AT MEAN SEA LEVEL NOW PASSES THROUGH GANGANAGAR, NARNAUL, GWALIOR, CHURK, GAYA, BEHRAMPORE AND THENCE EASTWARDS TO MANIPUR AND EXTENDS UPTO 0.9 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL.
- THE OFF-SHORE TROUGH AT MEAN SEA LEVEL FROM MAHARASHTRA COAST TO KARNATAKA COASTPERSISTS. THE EAST-WEST SHEAR ZONE ROUGHLY ALONG LAT.17°N PERSISTS AND NOW SEENBETWEEN 4.5 KM & 5.8 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL TILTING SOUTHWARDS WITH HEIGHT.
- THE NORTH-SOUTH TROUGH AT 0.9 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL FROM CENTRAL MADHYA PRADESH TOSOUTH TAMILNADU ACROSS VIDARBHA, TELANGANA AND RAYALASEEMA HAS BECOME LESS MARKED.
- THE CYCLONIC CIRCULATION OVER NORTH COASTAL ANDHRA PRADESH & NEIGHBOURHOOD AT 1.5 KMABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL HAS BECOME LESS MARKED.
- A LOW PRESSURE AREA IS LIKELY TO FORM OVER NORTHWEST BAY OF BENGAL
   & NEIGHBOURHOODAROUND 23RD JULY.

#### 3.0 Rainfall forecast for next 5 days issued on 19th July 2021 (Midday) by IMD



There is no heavy Rainfall warning in Basin states fo of Krishna Basin hence no flood situation for next five days.
