Light Rainfall of (11-25mm) is predicted in subcatchments of Pravara, Purna, Middle Godavari, Maneru, Lower Godavari, Indravathi and Sabari on Day 1, Upper Godavari, Purna, Maneru, Lower Godavari and Indravathi on Day 2, Upper Godavari, Pravara and Purna on Day 3, Upper Godavari, Pravara and Purna on Day 4 and Upper Godavari and Pravara on Day 5 of Godavari Basin.

Remaining catchments will receive Very light rainfall of (0.1-10mm) is predicted for the remaining Days of Godavari Basin. No Flood Situation During Next 5 Days in Godavari Basin.
